

# SHALLOW DRAFT DAY CRUISE

## Latham Whitehurst Park

### June 27, 2020

Do you have a dinghy, canoe, kayak, or other shallow draft craft? Here is a chance to get it out on the water.

We are having a shallow water draft cruise on Saturday, June 27th from 1100 to 1500 or whenever,



The floating dock is about 25' long and has five small cleats. Painters can also be tied to the ramp rail leading up from the dock. There is a kayak/canoe slip for entry and exit from your boat.

There are options for the length of your day cruise.

- If you leave from the launch ramp at the end of Habourside Drive the distance is about 6.3 nm.
- If you take your big boat into Upper Broad Creek, anchor near Blackbeard and start from there, distance is just over 4 nm. Of course, you could anchor farther up the creek and make it shorter.
- You could even drive around to Lee's Landing and launch. Distance is a little less than a mile up Broad Creek to Latham Whitehurst Docks. The drive to Lee's Landing is 20 miles or so from the FH main gate.



We are not renting the Pavilion this year and plan to meet by staying in our boats or sitting on the docks while maintaining social distancing (you'll need portable chairs).

Bring your picnic lunch and beverages of choice for great fellowship and a fun day at the park and on the water. Be sure to pack bug repellent and sun protection. Attached is a map of the park showing trails, facilities and docks.

If you do not have a boat and want to join us by car, it is about ¾ mile walk from the parking lot at the park to docks.


